The winners of the NYSTEEA Future Technology and Engineering Education Teacher Award will be notified of their award in July. At the END of the student's first semester, they are required to have earned a GPA of 2.5 or higher and continue to major in Technology Education. The student will then mail or email a copy of their grade report in order to receive the first \$500 award. The same procedure will be followed after the student's second semester in order to receive the final \$500 of the award.

NOTE: In the event that a student does not meet the requirements or fails to apply for the awarded funds within one month of completing their first or second semester, they will forfeit that individual amount. Monies that are forfeited will be available and offered to "runners up" as long as they meet the stated requirements.
